

Title VI Non-Discrimination Policy

Garrett Transit Services, a division of Garrett County Community Action Committee, Inc. is committed to ensuring that no person shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (PL 100.259), be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity, whether those programs and activities are federally funded or not.

If you believe that you have been subjected to unequal treatment due to race, color, or national origin, then you have the right to file a formal complaint. Complaints may be filed within one hundred eight (-180-) days following the alleged discriminatory actions.
