**Partners After School summer programs are well underway via donations from GCC Technologies LLC's Community Involvement Program and the Garrett County Department of Social Services. Community Action staff members are operating the Partners After School Program @ Grantsville from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, from June 30 through July 9, at the Grantsville Park. Staff of the Garrett County Health Department operate the Partners After School Programs @ Accident and Oakland. The Accident program will be offered at the Accident fire hall pavilion from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, from July 13 to 24. The program will serve Accident Elementary School students enrolled in third through fifth grades. The Oakland program is being offered at the Glades pavilion from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on July 6 to 10, 13, 15, and 17. Students enrolled in third through eighth grades at Broad Ford Elementary, Yough Glades Elementary, or Southern Middle schools are eligible to participate. The summer programs are free.
