

Garrett Transit To Be Closed On Tuesday For Training Event

Garrett Transit Service (GTS) will be closed on Tuesday, Nov. 3, so that all employees may participate in a training seminar conducted by the National Transit Institute (NTI) of Rutgers State University, N.J. The training will focus on driver, vehicle, and passenger safety.

Transportation services on Nov. 3, therefore, will *only* be available for the Accident Head Start, Friendsville Head Start, and Grantsville Early Head Start programs.

"All other transportation services will be suspended for the day," GTS director Gregan Crawford said. "Phone messages for service may be left by dialing GTS at 301-533-9010, and they will be returned when normal transit service operations resume on Wednesday, Nov. 4."

He added that more training opportunities are planned at GTS in the coming year, which will enhance the delivery of transit services and improve internal operations.

Garrett Transit Service is operated by Garrett County Community Action Committee Inc. It is a public, demand response transportation system that offers rides in and around the region, as well as out of state to all Garrett County residents and visitors.
