



**GTS DRIVER PLACES FIRST IN STATE EVENT –** Garrett Transit Service (GTS) has announced that one of its employees recently placed first in a driving competition held in Elkridge. James Kisner, a 15-year employee of GTS, competed against other transit drivers from across the state. The competition, hosted by the Transportation Association of Maryland Inc., included operating a bus through an obstacle course, testing on a pre-trip inspection, and demonstrating wheel chair securement. As a result of his first-place finish, Kisner will now compete in the Community Transportation Association drivers rodeo, a national competition that will be held May 21 and 22 in Portland, Ore. Operated by Community Action Committee, GTS is a public, demand response transportation system that offers rides in and around the region as well as out of the state to all Garrett County residents and visitors.
