

Garrett County Opry proceeds benefits Meals on Wheels

The concert kicks off with Loretta Hummel and Country Grass, featuring country, gospel and bluegrass music, including her song "God Bless the Soldiers," which is

in the top 20 on the Christian Voice Magazine Country-Gospel Chart.

Next up will be Second Wind, taking the stage at 7 p.m. with a mix of bluegrass and old-time country music. At 8 p.m., Wheeling Jamboree Star Steve Smith will bring his unique, banjo-fueled brand of country music to the stage. The concert will close with a 9 p.m. performance by The Durst Brothers featuring country oldies and original music.

the show, with performances throughout, by comedian Rusty Halo.

The Garrett County Opry will be held at the Garrett College Auditorium Theater, with the doors opening at 5 p.m. Children under 12 will be admitted free. Refreshments will be available.
