



As part of its continuing efforts to bring broadband to Garrett County, NeuBeam™ announced the opening of an Internet Connection Center at 360 W. Liberty Street in Oakland. The “ICC” stems from a joint program between NeuBeam and the USDA’s Rural Utilities Service to help bridge the nation’s Digital Divide. The space for the ICC has been provided by Garrett County Community Action Committee.

The ICC will be open to the general public with two kiosk terminals available that provide high-speed access to email, social media, shopping and other web content. Printing and scanning capabilities are also available. There is no charge for any of these services. The hours of operation are 8 am – 8 pm, seven days a week.
